This luxury condo is located on the 54th floor of One57, a building on West 57th Street constructed by architect Christian de Portzamparc in 2014.

Beyond the gallery entrance, the light-drenched open living and dining room features floor-to-ceiling windows with views of Central Park to the north, Midtown to the east, and the Chrysler Building and Empire State Building to the south. There's a gourmet kitchen and a separate wing that houses four en suite bedrooms, including the master, which has a sitting room and a marble bath. A fifth room could serve as another bedroom or a family room.

The building offers access to a health club with a pool and spa, a five-star restaurant, a library, and a screening room.
