The Fed Leaves Rates Unchanged

- <u>The Federal Reserve made no changes to interest rates or its bond purchases</u> after the FOMC met last week.
- They did, however, raise their expectations for economic growth and interest rates, as well as <u>move up their</u> <u>timeline for hiking interest rates</u>.
- St. Louis Fed President James Bullard told CNBC that rate increases could be coming as soon as next year.
- Stocks fell sharply on this news, with the Dow down 3.5% for the week.

Economic Headlines

- · Jobless claims unexpectedly rose to their highest level in a month.
- U.S. retail sales <u>fell by more than expected in May</u>.
- Producer prices rose 6.6% during the 12 months ending in May, their biggest annual increase on record.
- · Eight states opted out of federal unemployment programs last week.
- A new study finds that one-third of Americans will be retiring later than planned due to COVID-19.
- Bank of America says this year's consumer spending is running 20% higher than in 2019.
- The head of the International Monetary Fund believes <u>vaccines will be the most important economic policy this</u> year.

Housing News

- <u>A new study from the National Association of Realtors</u> found that the U.S. needs to build at least 5.5 million new homes just to keep up with demand.
- Housing starts rose 3.6% in May, while building permits fell 3.0%.
- Homebuilder confidence has fallen to a 10-month low, as rising costs have pushed home prices higher.

New York Update

- · Governor Cuomo has lifted most of New York's COVID-19 restrictions.
- New York City's job growth <u>has been fueled lately by restaurants and hotels</u>, which has brought the unemployment rate down to 10.9%.
- The City Council has passed a bill requiring racial-equity studies to be part of the rezoning process.
