FOREIGNER GUITARIST SCORES NEW NYC LOFT FOR \$4.9M

Rock on with your bad self!

Mick Jones, the 71-year-old guitarist and founding member of rock group Foreigner, has purchased a two-bedroom co-op at 420 West Broadway in Soho for \$4.9 million, The Post has learned.

The apartment, which has direct elevator access, sports brick walls, exposed beams, 14 oversized windows and high ceilings, according to its listing, which was marketed by Sophie Ravet and Rachel Glazer of Brown Harris Stevens. Its most recent asking price was \$5 million, StreetEasy shows.

There's also an open stainless steel-and-lacquer chef's kitchen, a fireplace and an L-shaped landscaped terrace space.

The building, which houses only eight other units, has a doorman and private storage units.

The deal has not yet entered public records, but loan documents appear in Jones' name.

Chase Landow, of Nest Seekers International, appears to have represented Jones in the transaction. He did not respond to a message seeking comment.
