■ Situated on Miami Beach's Venetian Islands, 8 W. Rivo Alto Drive makes the most of its waterfront location. Floor-to-ceiling glass overlooks the water, and the backyard offers more than 100 feet of water frontage. The 7,026-square-foot home, which boasts five bedrooms and seven-and-a-half baths, is on the market for \$22.5 million—making it one of the most expensive homes in Miami Beach.

A cascading water feature pays homage to the home's location, and a moat-like path leads across a reflecting pool and up a set of steps to the two-story mansion.

Double doors lead inside, where an elliptical staircase illuminated by a 300-square-foot skylight sets the stage for the rest of the trendy home. Floor-to-ceiling windows, an all-glass elevator, a glass-enclosed wine cellar, glass balconies, and a glass bathtub create a transparent look throughout.

Home chefs will have everything they need at their fingertips in the sophisticated Boffi kitchen, which features Sub-Zero and Miele appliances. The resort-style backyard features a swimming pool, hot tub, outdoor kitchen, and dining area. The home is on the market for \$22.5 million.
