Maurizio Gucci, the former head of the Gucci fashion house bought the apartment in the 1970s, along with a second apartment in the tower. He was murdered in Milan in 1995 and the apartment is still owned by the family.

Daniela V. Rivoir, Senior Vice President at Brown Harris Stevens has the listing. Rivoir has been a building broker specialist at the Olympic Tower (developed by Aristotle Onassis) since 2001.

And if you would rather buy a unit instead of renting, Corcoran is offering a unit on 25 East 77th Street on the Upper East Side for \$60,000,000. Monthly maintenance and taxes for that unit would set you back more than \$35,000 a month.
