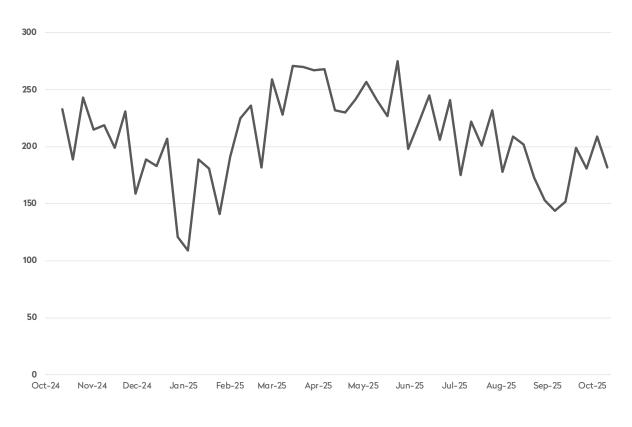

NUMBER OF SIGNED CONTRACTS



- The number of signed contracts declined 13% last week and was 22% lower than a year ago.
- Contracts to purchase resale apartments were down 12% from the previous week, while new developments fell by 19%.
- The biggest decline in activity last week was in apartments priced between \$2 million and \$3 million.
- Downtown from 14th to 34th Street was the only market area without a weekly decrease in signed contracts.
