

2025 WEEKLY CONTRACTS SIGNED REPORT

NUMBER OF SIGNED CONTRACTS



- The number of signed contracts fell 22% last week due in part to the celebration of Martin Luther King Jr. Day.
- Contracts were 35% higher than a year ago.
- There was a 28% increase in signed contracts last week for apartments priced between \$2 million and \$3 million.
- The East Side was the only market area with a weekly increase in contract activity, with 5% more deals reported than the week before.
