
2025 WEEKLY CONTRACTS SIGNED REPORT

NUMBER OF SIGNED CONTRACTS



- The number of signed contracts declined 10% last week and was 8% lower than a year ago.
- Resale contracts fell 9% from the previous week, while new developments were down 17%.
- Apartments priced between \$3 million and \$5 million experienced the biggest decrease in activity last week, with 35% fewer signed contracts than the week before.
- The West Side was the only market area with an increase in activity last week.
