

## 2025 WEEKLY CONTRACTS SIGNED REPORT

### NUMBER OF SIGNED CONTRACTS



- The number of signed contracts fell 10% last week and was 17% below last year's level.
- Resale contracts were 10% lower than the previous week, while new developments fell 8%.
- Apartments priced between \$3 million and \$5 million was the only price category with more contracts than the week before.
- The West Side was the only market area with a weekly increase in contract activity.
