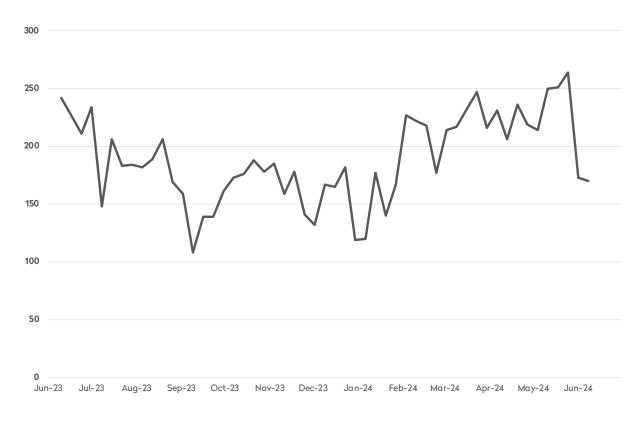

NUMBER OF SIGNED CONTRACTS



- The number of signed contracts fell 2% last week and was 30% lower than a year ago.
- Resale contracts were 3% higher than the previous week, while new development activity declined 28%.
- Apartments priced between \$3 million and \$5 million experienced a 23% jump in activity last week, the biggest gain of any price category.
- South of 14th Street led all market areas with a 42% increase in contract signings last week.
