
NUMBER OF SIGNED CONTRACTS



- Contract activity fell sharply last week due to the Independence Day holiday, but it was 3% higher than a year ago.
- Resale contracts were up 6% year-over-year, while new developments declined 17%.
- Compared to the same week in 2023, apartments priced between \$2 million and \$3 million were the only price category with a decrease in signed contracts.
- Midtown posted the biggest increase in contract activity compared to a year ago, rising 29%.
