
NUMBER OF SIGNED CONTRACTS



- While the number of signed contracts dipped 2% last week, they were still 5% higher than a year ago.
- Resale contracts rose 5% last week, while new developments fell 34%.
- The biggest increase in activity last week for any price range was the 75% jump in contracts for apartments priced over \$5 million.
- South of 14th Street posted a 30% weekly increase in signed contracts, the most of any market area.
