TOP STORY

EMPLOYMENT ROSE MORE THAN EXPECTED IN DECEMBER

- Payrolls rose by 216,000 last month, easily beating the Dow Jones forecast of 170,000.
- Here's a chart of job growth last month by industry.
- The number of job openings declined by 62,000, but remained at a historically high level of 8.79 million.
- Initial claims for unemployment fell 18,000 to 202,000.

ECONOMIC HEADLINES


- The three major stock indexes snapped a nine-week winning streak.
- Congressional leaders say they've reached an agreement on government funding.
- Service-sector growth slowed sharply in December.
- Corporate earnings are expected to rise faster in 2024 than last year.
- Falling response rates are <u>hurting the quality of the data</u> in government surveys.
- Construction spending in the U.S. rose less than expected in November.
- Activity in the manufacturing sector contracted for the 14th consecutive month in December.
- Online holiday spending <u>hit a record \$222.1 billion last year.</u>

HOUSING NEWS

- Despite falling rates, mortgage demand fell 9.4% in the final week of 2023.
- Mortgage rates were virtually unchanged last week, but economists expect more declines this year.
- The slowdown in the housing market is threatening sectors <u>like home improvement and storage</u>.
- The spread between 30-year mortgage rates and 10-year Treasuries has narrowed for the past eight weeks.
- According to U-Haul, Texas was the number one state Americans moved to last year.
- Big residential property investors are finding it harder to buy in good neighborhoods, so they are building new ones.

NEW YORK UPDATE

- The fourth quarter was a strong one for Manhattan office leasing.
- According to Governor Hochul, more than 1,500 lane miles of state and local highways were improved, and more than 2,800 bridges were replaced or improved during 2023.
- Beginning January 1, the minimum wage is now \$16 per hour in NYC, Long Island and Westchester County, and \$15 per hour in the rest of NYS.
- Citi Bike prices <u>rose on January 4</u>.
