TOP STORY

CORE INFLATION LOWER THAN EXPECTED IN DECEMBER

- Core CPI rose less than expected last month.
- Here's a table of price changes over the past year by item.
- Housing inflation fell to its <u>lowest annual level in three years</u>.
- Producer prices also <u>rose less than expected</u> in December.

ECONOMIC HEADLINES

- Stocks posted strong gains last week.
- Wall Street has high hopes for strong earnings in 2025, even though plenty of hurdles await.
- Retail sales rose less than expected in December.
- Weekly jobless claims ticked up to 217,000.
- <u>U.S. industrial production</u> rose in December by more than forecast.
- The U.S. budget deficit in December was 39.4% higher than a year ago.
- Oil prices rose for the fourth straight week.
- Economists expect the Los Angeles fire to <u>have a limited national economic impact</u>.
- House Republicans are pushing to extend the 2017 tax cuts.
- These are the cities with the most high-paying jobs in the U.S.
- According to human resource provider Gusto, the average year-end bonus for employees <u>rose 2% last year</u>, but fewer workers are getting them.
- The World Bank says the global is economy is growing steadily, but not fast enough to help ease poverty.

- The average 30-year mortgage rate <u>rose to 7.04%</u>, its highest level in eight months.
- Even with rising rates, mortgage demand started 2025 stronger than last year.
- U.S. single-family homebuilding $\underline{\text{rose to a 10-month high}}$ in December.
- It has become very hard for first-time homebuyers to find starter homes.
- <u>75% of Americans</u> think owning a home is still a part of the American dream.
 Displaced Los Angeles-area residents <u>face spiking rents</u> as authorities warn of price gouging.
- According to senior living website Seniorly.com, Washington D.C. outranks all 50 states <u>as the best place to retire</u>.

- Manufacturing activity declined in NYS in January.
