TOP STORY

JOB GROWTH MUCH HIGHER THAN EXPECTED IN JANUARY

- Employment rose by 353,000 in January, easily beating the 185,000 Dow Jones estimate.
- Here's a chart of job growth last month by industry.
- The number of job openings rose to 9.026 million in December, its highest level in three months.
- Initial claims for unemployment rose to 224,000.

ECONOMIC HEADLINES

- The S&P 500 rose for the fourth-straight week to a record 4,958.61.
- The Federal Reserve held rates steady, and made it clear they are not ready to start cutting.
- Consumer confidence rose to its highest level in more than two years.
- Worker productivity grew faster than expected in the fourth quarter.
- US manufacturing output hits highest level since October 2022.
- Here's how interest rates for different types of loans have changed over the past year.
- U.S. labor costs <u>rose less than expected</u> in the fourth quarter.
- Rents at the highest-end office buildings <u>have started falling</u>, while the pace of leasing as slowed.
- · Retail property owners are limiting discounts and other concessions, as demand for space has increased.
- The number of workers guitting their jobs fell 12% in 2023.
- The International Monetary Fund expects the global economy to grow 3.1% in 2024 and 3.2% in 2025.

HOUSING NEWS

- Mortgage applications to purchase a home fell 11%, as the supply of home for sale remained low.
- The average 30-year conforming mortgage rate fell to 6.63%.
- · According to the S&P CoreLogic Case-Shiller national home price index home prices fell 0.2% in November, their first monthly drop in a year.
- · Here are the 15 most expensive U.S. neighborhoods according to Homes.com, ranked by price per square foot.
- The national homeownership rate dipped to 65.7% in 4Q23.
- Here are ways to get a 6% mortgage even before the Fed cuts rates.
- An increase in supply has rental prices starting to come down.

NEW YORK UPDATE

- New York airports had a record 144 million travelers last year.
- The MTA collected \$636 million less through state real estate taxes in 2023 compared to 2022.
- New York Community Bank's shares fell 38%, as loan losses surged.
- The MTA has rolled out its new "open gangway" subway cars.
