ECONOMIC HEADLINES

- The S&P 500 closed above 5,000 for the first time ever on Friday.
- Inflation was lower in December than originally reported.
- U.S. services activity <u>expanded more than expected</u> in January.
- Initial claims for unemployment <u>fell to 218,000</u>.
- There are thousands of jobs being added every month, but layoffs are still happening.
- Credit card debt rose to \$1.13 trillion in the fourth quarter, as delinquencies rose over 50% in 2023.
- According to Layoffs.fyi, 32,000 tech workers have lost their jobs this year.
- The U.S. trade deficit rose to \$62.2 billion in December.

HOUSING NEWS

- The average 30-year conforming mortgage rate ticked up to 6.64% last week.
- America's most expensive home just hit the market in Naples for \$295 million.
- Homebuyers took advantage of the recent decline in mortgage rates.
- More than <u>18 million rental units are at risk from climate hazards</u>, according to a recent study by Harvard University's Joint Center for Housing Studies.
- Home values could decline in fire- and flood-prone areas, as insurance companies pull back coverage.
- According to NAR, home prices <u>are still rising in 85% of cities</u>.

NEW YORK UPDATE

- NYC's rental vacancy rate <u>fell to 1.4% last year</u>, its lowest level since 1968.
- The MTA plans on rolling out <u>congestion pricing tolling in mid-June</u>.
- Moody's has downgraded <u>NYCB's credit rating to junk status</u>.
- 70 New York City Housing Authority employees were arrested in a federal corruption investigation.
- Here's why there are New York apartment buildings for sale for 50% off.
- The Port Authority of New York and New Jersey is advancing a <u>\$10 billion vision</u> to reimagine its Midtown bus terminal.
- When asked by the NYS Senate and Assembly about good cause eviction, the Mayor was noncommittal.
- According to the Citizens Budget Commission, <u>Mayor Adams omitted \$3.6 billion in costs</u> from the \$109 billion spending plan released last month.
