TOP STORY

CONSUMER PRICES ROSE MORE THAN EXPECTED IN JANUARY

- The consumer price index rose 0.5% last month, higher than the 0.3% forecast.
- <u>Here's a breakdown</u> of price changes over the past year by item.
- Producer prices also <u>rose more than expected</u> in January.

ECONOMIC HEADLINES

- Even with the higher-than-expected inflation data, all three major stock averages posted gains last week.
- Retail sales <u>fell more than expected</u> in January.
- Initial claims for unemployment <u>fell by 7,000</u> in the week ending February 8.
- U.S. manufacturing output <u>fell in January</u>.
- Fed Chair Powell said central bank doesn't "need to be in a hurry" to lower interest rates further.
- The CEO of Bank of America believes the Fed will not cut rates this year.
- Credit card debt hit a record \$1.21 trillion in the fourth quarter of 2024.
- President Trump has ordered <u>25% tariffs on steel and aluminum imports</u>. He also is <u>imposing reciprocal tariffs</u> on countries that are placing tariffs or other unfair trade limitations on U.S. goods.
- U.S. consumers' long-term inflation expectations edged higher in January.
- President Trump has ordered the U.S. Treasury to stop minting pennies.

HOUSING NEWS

- The average 30-year mortgage rate fell to 6.87% last week.
- Mortgage refinancings rose to their highest level since October.
- More homes for sale are being delisted, as buyers have become scarcer.
- The senior-housing market is picking up <u>due to aging baby boomers</u>.
- Economists believe <u>2025 could be a renter's market</u> but it won't last.

NEW YORK UPDATE

- The U.S. Department of Justice is dropping the federal corruption case against NYC Mayor Eric Adams.
- These are the 10 U.S. cities New Yorkers want to move to most according to Streeteasy.
- The NYC Comptroller's Office has issued their Monthly Economic and Fiscal Outlook.
- Manhattan Borough President Market Levine will oppose the zoning changes for Related's Hudson Yards casino.
