TOP STORY

275,000 JOBS ADDED IN FEBRUARY

- Employment rose by 275,000 last month, much higher than the Wall Street forecast of 198,000.
- Here's a graph of job growth last month by industry.
- The unemployment rate rose to a two-year high of 3.9%.
- Weekly jobless claims were unchanged at 217,000.
- The number of job openings dipped to 8.86 million in January.

ECONOMIC HEADLINES

- All three major stock indexes posted declines last week.
- President Biden delivered his State of the Union Address, where he promised to reshape the corporate tax system.
- Growth in the services industry slowed in February.
- Chairman Powell told lawmakers the Fed is not ready to discuss cutting interest rates.
- · According to a report by Careerio, these cities have the toughest competition for highly paid jobs.
- Worker productivity rose at a 3.2% annualized rate in the fourth quarter.
- President Biden will launch a joint FTC-DOJ task force to stop "unfair and illegal" corporate pricing.
- Foreign exchange strategists surveyed by Reuters expect the U.S. dollar's strength to continue in the near term.
- Jeff Bezos has passed Elon Musk to become the world's richest person again.
- The Consumer Financial Protection Board will be capping credit card late fees at \$8.
- The U.S. trade deficit <u>rose 5.1% in January</u>, as imports surged.
- Even the Cookie Monster is mad about shrinkflation.
- The national average credit score <u>fell in October</u>, its first decline in a decade.

HOUSING NEWS

- Mortgage rates fell for the first time in five weeks.
- Demand for home purchase mortgages rose 11% in the week ending March 1, as more homes hit the market.
- <u>Here are the states</u> with the highest and lowest average monthly rents.

NEW YORK UPDATE

- Governor Hochul sent National Guard members to the subways to combat crime.
- New York State's private-sector employment level hit a record high in January.
- This could be the year <u>NYC curbs real estate broker fees</u>.
- NYC Council Speaker Adams said the City Council will push to undo many of the spending cuts Mayor Adams has imposed since last year.
- The City Planning Commission has voted to advance Mayor Adams' "<u>City of Yes for Economic Opportunity</u>" zoning changes.
