#### JOB GROWTH MUCH HIGHER THAN EXPECTED IN MARCH

- Payrolls rose by 303,000 last month, easily beating the Dow Jones forecast of 200,000.

### **NEW YORK UPDATE**

- Four of New York City's five boroughs have lost a higher percentage of residents since COVID <u>than any of the 40</u> largest counties in the country.
- Overdue property taxes have reached a record \$880 million in NYC.
- Manhattan's office availability rate hit a record 18.1% in 1Q24 according to Colliers.
- The NYC Council says it's found <u>\$3.35 billion more in tax revenue</u> for next year that the Mayor hasn't accounted for in his budget.
- Retail availability rates in NYC are back to pre-Covid levels.
