TOP STORY

INFLATION HIGHER THEN EXPECTED IN MARCH

- Consumer prices rose 3.5% over the past year, slightly higher than the 3.4% forecast.
- "Supercore" inflation—which the Fed looks at carefully—is up 4.8% over the past year.
- The March inflation report now has markets expecting only two rate cuts in 2024, which should begin in September.
- Producer prices <u>rose less than expected</u> in March.

ECONOMIC HEADLINES

- All three major stock indexes posted declines last week.
- The Conference Board's employment trends index rose in March, indicating a pickup in hiring in the next few months.
- Futures traders have reduced bets on how much the Federal Reserve will cut rates this year.
- Fed officials have made it clear they are in no rush to cut rates.
- <u>Consumers' expectations on inflation have stabilized</u>, but they are increasingly concerned about their ability to pay back debt.
- Treasury Secretary Yellen says the <u>U.S. is ready to sanction Chinese banks</u> if they aid Russia's war machine.
- 65% of Americans say they're living paycheck to paycheck.
- <u>Small business optimism</u> hit an 11-year low, as inflation fears won't go away.
- Here are the 10 fastest growing retail brands in the U.S. according to Yelp.
- According to WalletHub, these are the best states for working from home.

HOUSING NEWS

- The average 30-year conforming mortgage rate ticked up to 6.88% last week.
- · Mortgage demand is falling for purchases, but rising for refinances.
- The hidden costs of homeownership such as insurance and property taxes are skyrocketing.
- Almost 75% of buyers of newly built homes <u>had regrets about their purchase</u>, with property taxes being the most common complaint.
- According to NAR, these are the 11 cities where you need to earn over \$200,000 to buy a typical home.

- The NYC Comptroller's office has released its Monthly Economic and Fiscal Outlook for April.
- NYS Comptroller DiNapoli has called for better reporting and monitoring of NYC capital projects.
- REBNY reports a continued decline in applications for residential building foundations in NYC.
- NYC's industrial sector had its <u>busiest first quarter since 2019</u>.
- The NYC Council has passed a huge Willets Point rezoning.
