ECONOMIC HEADLINES

- Economic growth was weaker than expected in 1Q24.
- The Fed's preferred measure of inflation rose 2.8% over the past year.
- Here's a look at why inflation remains above the Fed's target rate.
- Both the S&P 500 and Nasdag indexes posted their best weeks since November.
- Orders for durable goods were slightly higher than expected in March.
- Initial claims for unemployment fell to their lowest level in nine weeks.

- The Biden Administration has issued a rule banning fossil fuel use in new federal buildings starting in 2030.
