ECONOMIC HEADLINES

- All three major stock indexes had losing weeks, but the Dow had its best day of the year on Friday.
- The Fed's preferred measure of inflation rose 0.2% in April and was 2.8% higher than a year ago.
- Consumer confidence rose in May for the first time in three months.
- Jobless claims rose to 219,000 last week.
- GDP rose less than originally reported in 1Q24.
- According to NerdWallet, 25% of consumers recently used a buy now, pay later loan.
- Profits for the U.S. banking sector <u>surged 79.5% to \$64.2 billion</u> in the first guarter of 2024.
- Global debt has reached \$315 trillion according to the Institute of International Finance.
- Businesses are growing more pessimistic on the economic outlook according to a recent Fed survey.

HOUSING NEWS

- Mortgage Rates rose back above 7%.
- Pending home sales fell to their lowest level since April 2020.
- Home price growth slowed in March, according to the Federal Housing Finance Agency.
- Realtor.com and NAR have issued a joint report on the <u>impact lower mortgage rates would have on the housing market</u>.
- These are the cities where mortgage payments rose the most the past two years.
- · According to SmartAsset, these are the cities where homeowners pay more than renters.
- NAR has issued a report examining five financial solutions for first-time buyers.

NEW YORK UPDATE

- Wall Street is ordering <u>more staffers to be in the office five days a week</u>, as regulatory changes make it harder to allow remote work.
- According to The Partnership for New York City, the return of office workers <u>has plateaued at 72% of pre-pandemic levels</u>.
- The Trucking Association of New York is suing to block congestion pricing.
- The MTA is prepared to pay \$1 million for a consultant to study why riders skip fares.
- State Senator Ramos said she will block Steve Cohen's \$8 billion casino project by Citi Field.
- The NYC Council is pushing to bring back the J-51 tax abatement.
