TOP STORY

JOB GROWTH MUCH HIGHER THAN EXPECTED IN MAY

- Payrolls rose by 272,000 last month, easily beating the Dow Jones estimate of 190,000.
- <u>Here's a chart</u> of employment gains by industry in May.
- The strong jobs report has markets less optimistic about rate cuts this year.
- Job openings fell to a three-year low in April.
- Initial claims for unemployment <u>ticked up 8,000 to 229,000</u>.

ECONOMIC HEADLINES

- All three major stock indexes rose last week.
- The services sector of the economy expanded at a rapid pace in May.
- Manufacturing activity slowed for the second straight month in May.
- · Construction spending unexpectedly fell in April.
- The U.S. dollar is at its strongest since the 1980s.
- Household wealth hit a record \$160 trillion in the U.S. during the first quarter.
- Pay increases for those switching jobs are declining.
- The U.S. trade deficit rose by 9% in April.
- Americans get more income from their investments than ever before.
- The average 401(k) savings rate hit a record 14.2% in the first quarter of 2024.
- According to the World Economic Forum, <u>these are the economic threats</u> global business leaders worry about the most.
- The typical CEO makes nearly 200 times more than their workers.
- The U.S. added 500,000 new millionaires last year.

HOUSING NEWS

- Mortgage demand fell for the second straight week.
- Mortgage rates fell back below 7%.
- About 36% of surveyed Americans ranked real estate as the top long-term investment.
- NAR is empowering "vocal volunteers" to educate buyers and sellers about the value of a real estate professional.

NEW YORK UPDATE

- Governor Hochul indefinitely postponed the start of congestion pricing, and is now proposing raising business taxes to replace the revenue.
- NYC received 150,000 applications for affordable housing vouchers in just 12 hours.
- The NYC Department of Housing Preservation & Development has released guidelines on the <u>tax exemptions for</u> converting commercial buildings to affordable housing.
- The City Council has approved Mayor Adams' "City of Yes" proposal to update NYC zoning rules.
- <u>Brooklyn is leading NYC's small business boom</u> according to a new report from the NYC Economic Development Corp.
- Multiple studies conclude that workers don't want to return to their offices full time because they <u>don't want to</u> <u>commute long distances</u>.
