ECONOMIC HEADLINES

- The S&P 500 was up 14.5% in the first half of 2024.
- The Fed's favorite measure of inflation <u>rose 2.6% over the past year</u>, in line with expectations.
- Consumer confidence fell in June due to a weaker outlook for the economy.
- Initial jobless claims declined last week, but continuing claims rose to a 2-1/2 year high.
- U.S. core capital goods orders <u>fell sharply in May</u>.
- All 31 banks passed the Federal Reserve's annual stress test.
- · According to the latest CNBC CFO Council survey, corporate CFOs are losing some confidence in the economy.
- Two federal judges have blocked significant parts of President Biden's new student loan repayment plan.
- Economic growth for the first quarter was revised up slightly to a 1.4% rate.
- These are the highest paid CEOs in the U.S.
- A "vibecession" is the disconnect between the economy's strength and its perceived weakness among households.
- Americans are now experiencing the "funflation" effect as they spend more money on travel and entertainment.
- Fewer U.S. households have bought life insurance in recent decades.

HOUSING NEWS

- The average 30-year mortgage rate <u>declined for the fourth straight week</u>.
- Mortgage demand hasn't moved much the past two weeks.
- Pending home sales fell to a record low in May.
- New home sales fell to a six-month low in May.
- · According to the S&P CoreLogic Case-Shiller National Home Price Index, home prices hit a record high in April and are 47% higher than in early 2020.
- Here's where rents are rising—and falling—the fastest, according to Zumper.
- Treasury Secretary Janet Yellen is rolling out a <u>slate of financing initiatives</u> to support new housing development including a \$100 million fund for affordable housing.
- New homes on the market these days are smaller than those built a decade ago.
- According to Clever Real Estate, it costs an average of \$54,616 to sell a house.

NEW YORK UPDATE

- Mayor Adams and the NYC Council have agreed on a record-breaking \$112.4 billion budget.
- The MTA Board voted 10-1 to approve Governor Hochul's pause on congestion pricing.
- Drivers in NYC <u>lost 101 hours to traffic jams</u> in 2023, according to the INRIX Global Traffic Scorecard.
- The NYC Department of City Planning has released a rezoning framework in Long Island City that could create up to 14,000 new homes.
- · Hotel occupancy in New York is within a half percentage point of where it was in 2019 for the first time since the start of the pandemic.
- · According to a study by the NYS Comptroller's Office, outer-borough businesses outperformed Manhattan during the pandemic.
- The NYC Ferry is looking to sell corporate naming rights to avoid sinking money troubles.
