CONSUMER PRICES FELL IN JUNE

- The consumer price index <u>declined 0.1% in June</u>, its first monthly decrease since May 2020.
- <u>Here's a breakdown</u> of price changes by item over the past year.

ECONOMIC HEADLINES

- So far in 2024, the S&P 500 is up nearly 18%.
- Fed Chair Powell expressed concern that holding rates too high for too long <u>could jeopardize economic</u> arowth.
- Consumer sentiment dipped in July.
- The recent surge in the U.S. labor force may have raised the number of jobs needed to avoid an increase in the unemployment rate <u>to around 230,000 a month</u>, according to the San Francisco Fed.
- The Covid pandemic <u>caused \$18 trillion in economic losses to the U.S.</u>, according to a report by Heritage Foundation's Nonpartisan Commission on China and COVID-19.
- Record summer air travel <u>hasn't translated into record airline profits</u>.
- The number of U.S. companies that filed for bankruptcy last month topped the <u>highs seen during the</u> early stages of the pandemic in 2020.
- Even with the decline in inflation, shoppers are still complaining about high prices.
- Hedge funds <u>posted mediocre returns</u> in the first half of 2024.
- Nearly half of Gen Zers receive financial help from their parents.
- The presidential election <u>shouldn't influence how you invest</u>, financial experts say.
