TOP STORY

JOB GROWTH MUCH LOWER THAN EXPECTED IN JULY

- Employment rose by 114,000 in July, well below the 185,000 Dow Jones forecast.
- The unemployment rate rose to 4.3%, its highest level since October 2021.
- The number of job openings ticked down to 8.18 million at the end of June.
- The number of Americans filing for jobless claims hit its highest level in a year.

ECONOMIC HEADLINES


- The weaker-than-expected jobs report <u>pushed stocks down sharply</u> on Friday.
- The Fed left rates unchanged, while noting the progress made on inflation.
- Fed Chair Powell said a September rate cut is on the table, if inflation data continues to cool.
- <u>Here what changed</u> in the new Fed statement.
- Consumer confidence rose in July due to improving expectations for the economy.
- Manufacturing activity in the U.S. fell to an eight-month low in July.
- Pay and benefits for America's workers grew more slowly in the second quarter than in the first three months of the year.
- Worker productivity rose in the second quarter of 2024.
- In the second quarter of 2024, one million people had a federal student loan balance of more than \$200,000, according to the U.S. Dept of Education.
- According to the 2023 Global Traffic Scorecard, the traditional 9-5 workday has shifted to 10-to-4.
- These are the 10 worst states to retire in the U.S., according to Bankrate.
- The euro zone economy grew faster than expected in the second quarter.

HOUSING NEWS

- The average 30-year mortgage rate fell to its lowest level since early February.
- Pending homes sales rose sharply in June.
- · According to the Mortgage Bankers Association, housing affordability is moving in the right direction.
- <u>Home prices hit a record in May, according to the S&P CoreLogic Case-Shiller National Home Price Index.</u>
- · Homeowners insurance premiums rose 21% last year, according to data from Policygenius.
- Some of America's poorest states have the highest homeownership rates.
- Construction spending unexpectedly fell in June.

NEW YORK UPDATE

- NYC Comptroller Brad Lander is challenging Mayor Eric Adams in next year's Democratic primary.
- The MTA has outlined a list of needed improvements that exceed \$51.5 billion.
- Nearly half of the affordable housing units built in fiscal 2024 received the 421a tax break.
- There were about \$7.4 billion worth of investment sales during the second quarter, up significantly from the first quarter of 2024.
- It costs New York City \$3,300 to plant a tree.
