TOP STORY

THE FED HOLDS RATES STEADY

- For the second time in their last three meetings, <u>the Federal Reserve did not raise rates</u> but did warn they would remain higher than expected next year.
- The Fed also said it expects to raise rates one more time this year.

ECONOMIC HEADLINES

- The S&P 500 and Nasdaq posted their worst weeks since March.
- Initial claims for unemployment fell to their lowest level in eight months.
- Here's what happens if the federal government shuts down.
- The U.S. national debt reached \$33 trillion for the first time last week.
- Employers are expected to face the biggest increase in healthcare costs in a decade next year.
- Credit card losses are rising at the fastest pace since the Great Financial Crisis.
- U.S. consumers expect to <u>cut back on spending through the holidays</u>.
- The odds of the Fed engineering a soft landing have improved, but it remains a very difficult task.
- Government hiring has accounted for almost one-fifth of all jobs added so far in 2023.
- A growing number of Wall Street analysts think oil could hit \$100 a barrel.
- Since 2009, manufacturing output per hour in the U.S. has grown just 0.2% per year.
- <u>Here's a look</u> at what the economic cost will be to defeat inflation.
- The euro zone economy most likely contracted in 3Q23.

HOUSING NEWS

- The average 30-year conforming mortgage rate ticked up to 7.19%.
- Existing home sales were 15.3% lower in August than a year ago.
- Housing starts <u>fell to a three-year low last month</u>, while building permits jumped 6.9%.
- <u>Homebuilder sentiment went negative for the first time in seven months</u>, due mostly to higher mortgage rates.
- Home prices are expected to rise in 2024, according to many real estate economists.

NEW YORK UPDATE

- NYC Mayor Adams launched his "<u>City of Yes for Housing Opportunity</u>" program, which he says will create an additional 100,000 homes for over 250,000 New Yorkers.
- Mayor Adams also announced that beginning March 1, 2024, <u>all commercial trash must be in a secure</u>, <u>lidded container</u>.
- Moody's raised its credit outlook for the MTA, after NYS directed more tax revenue to the agency.
- Increasingly more <u>NYC co-ops are facing financial trouble</u> due to surging costs.
- According to the Community Housing Improvement Program, rent-stabilized tenants in NYC <u>remain more</u> than \$1 billion behind on their rent payments.
