TOP STORY

EMPLOYMENT MUCH HIGHER THAN EXPECTED IN SEPTEMBER

- The U.S. economy added 254,000 jobs last month, easily beating the 150,000 Dow Jones forecast.
- Here's a chart of job growth by industry in September.
- The number of job openings unexpectedly rose in August.
- Weekly jobless claims ticked up to 225,000.

ECONOMIC HEADLINES

- The Dow closed the week at a record high.
- There is a tentative agreement to end the port strike, but the deal is far from done.
- In a speech on Monday, Fed Chair Powell indicated that future rate cuts may be smaller than 50 basis points.
- U.S. services sector activity rose to a 1-1/2 year high in September.
- Manufacturing activity contracted for the sixth straight month in September.
- Construction spending unexpectedly fell in August.
- According to a survey by G-P, 59% of executives say the results of the November election have the potential to dramatically change the course of their business strategy.
- A federal judge has ruled the Biden administration <u>can move forward with student loan forgiveness</u>.
- A federal appeals court ruled betting on congressional elections is lawful.

- Mortgage rates spiked after the stronger-than-expected jobs report.
- Homes are turning over at their lowest rate in at least 30 years, according to Redfin.

- REBNY has released its <u>August Manhattan Office Building Visitation Report</u>.
- New York's cannabis market has produced nearly \$654M in sales.
