## INFLATION SLIGHTLY HIGHER THAN EXPECTED IN SEPTEMBER

- Consumer prices rose 0.4% last month, and were 3.7% higher than a year ago. Both figures were slightly above Wall Street forecasts.
- Here's a look at which products experienced a decline in price over the past year.
- Inflation remains well above the Fed's 2% target, here's why it may take a long time to achieve that goal.
- Producer prices also rose more than expected in September.

#### **ECONOMIC HEADLINES**


- The S&P 500 posted its second straight winning week.
- Most economists surveyed by the Wall Street Journal believe the U.S. will avoid recession, and the Fed is done raising rates.
- Weekly jobless claims remain at historically low levels.
- The International Monetary Fund has raised it forecast for U.S. economic growth this year.
- Americans 65 years or older <u>now account for 22% of consumer spending</u>, the highest percentage since records began in 1972.
- <u>Professor Claudia Goldin of Harvard University</u> won the Nobel economics prize, for her work on women in the labor market.
- Small-business optimism <u>fell in September</u>.
- · Minutes from the Fed's September meeting indicate that most members believe one more rate hike is needed.
- Workers returning to their offices are spending much more per day than before the pandemic.
- The richest Americans have seen their share of household net worth rise 1.5% since 2019.
- U.S. GDP has returned to its pre-pandemic path sooner than other nations, due to the willingness of Americans to spend their "excess savings."

## HOUSING NEWS

- The housing industry sent a letter to Fed Chair Powell, asking him to stop raising rates.
- Mortgage rates rose to an average of 7.57 last week, the ninth straight week rates have been over 7%.
- A decline in rates for adjustable-rate mortgages <u>has led to a spike in demand</u>.
- Here are the cities with the highest percentage of solo renters.

#### **NEW YORK UPDATE**

- According to data from Handshake, New York City is the top destination for job-seeking college grads.
- The NYC Comptroller's Office has released its <u>Monthly Economic and Fiscal Outlook</u>, which contains a special section on the city's technology sector.
- Wall Street's first half profits were 4.3% lower than in 2022.
- Beginning in the fall of 2024, residential buildings with nine of fewer units will be required to place trash in secure containers.
