# **TOP STORY**

### RETAIL SALES MUCH STRONGER THAN EXPECTED LAST MONTH

- Retail sales rose 0.7% in September, easily beating the 0.3% Dow Jones estimate.
- The better-than-expected report on spending brought the yield on 10-year treasuries to its highest level since July 2007.

## ECONOMIC HEADLINES

- All three major stock indexes posted losses last week.
- Initial claims for unemployment fell to 198,000, their lowest level since January.
- Net worth for the typical household jumped 37% from 2019 to 2022, reaching a median of \$192,900.
- Fed Chairman Powell said that inflation remains too high, and the economy must cool further to bring it down to the Fed's 2% target.
- The federal government ended fiscal year 2023 with a \$1.7 trillion deficit, <u>23% higher than the prior year</u>.
- U.S. industrial production rose to its highest level in almost five years in September.
- The Fed is not expected to raise rates at its meeting next week.
- Big banks are laying off thousands of employees.
- According to a LendingTree study, 51% of adults say they are better off financially than their parents were at their age.
- Treasury Secretary Yellen believes that the U.S. can afford to financially support both Israel and Ukraine in their war efforts.
- It's becoming too expensive to have fun, as ticket prices for concerts, sporting events, and amusement parks have surged.

## HOUSING NEWS

- 30-year mortgage rates hit 8% for the first time since 2000.
- Demand for mortgages fell to the lowest level since 1995.
- According to Redfin, homebuyers now need an annual income of \$114,627 to afford a median-priced house in the U.S.
- Sales of existing homes in September fell to their lowest level since October 2010.
- Housing starts rose 7% last month, while building permits declined 4.4%.
- The residential brokerage commission system could face a federal antitrust probe.

#### **NEW YORK UPDATE**

- NYC saw a surge in hiring last month, with 22,900 jobs added.
- New York State manufacturing activity fell into contraction in October.
- NYC will limit migrant family shelter stays to 60 days.
- A report by the Community Service Society of New York found that one in three New Yorkers spends half their income on rent
- The New York Building Congress expects both construction spending and employment to be higher this year than in 2022.
- According to Care.com, the average price of infant care in NYC is \$45,490 per year.
- Data from Kastle Systems shows that Tuesday has the highest percentage of workers in their NYC offices.
