TOP STORY

CONSUMER PRICES UP 3.1% FROM A YEAR AGO

- The consumer price index rose 0.1% last month and was 3.1% higher than a year ago.
- Here's a breakdown of the annual change in prices by item.
- Producer prices were unchanged in November.

THE FED HOLDS RATES STEADY

- The Federal Reserve made no changes to interest rates, but did indicate that three rate cuts were planned for next year.

- Fed Chairman Powell said the unique economic conditions created by the pandemic have <u>helped the Fed in its efforts</u> to engineer a soft landing.
