#### **ECONOMIC HEADLINES**

- Retail sales <u>rose more than expected</u> in March.
- The S&P 500 index finished the holiday-shortened week down.
- Weekly jobless claims fell by 9,000 to 215,000.
- More than 60% of CEOs expect a recession in the next 6 months according to a monthly survey from Chief Executive.
- President Trump continued to call for the Fed to cut rates, and said chairman Powell's <u>"termination cannot come fast enough."</u>
- National Economic Council Director Kevin Hassett said he is not expecting a recession this year.
- <u>Unemployment concerns are on the rise</u> among American workers.
- Industrial production fell by 0.3% in March.
- President Trump hinted the end of the tariff spat with China may be in sight.
- Fed Chair Powell said the central bank could find itself in a dilemma between <u>controlling inflation and</u> <u>supporting economic growth</u>.
- The World Trade Organization warned that the outlook for global trade has "deteriorated sharply."
- Investors are growing concerned about a U.S. asset exodus as Treasurys and the dollar decline.
- Ukraine said it has signed the outline of a minerals deal with the U.S.
- The U.S. economy is set to <u>lose billions of dollars in revenue in 2025</u> from a pullback in foreign tourism and boycotts of American products.
- Most companies say <u>high costs will keep them from moving manufacturing back to the U.S.</u>, according to a new CNBC Supply Chain survey.
- President Trump is seriously considering ideas to raise taxes on the rich.
- A group of small businesses <u>sued President Donald Trump</u>, seeking to block the new tariffs that he has imposed on imports in recent weeks.
- President Donald Trump said he is looking to "help some of the car companies."

### HOUSING NEWS

- The average 30-year conforming mortgage rate rose to 6.83% last week.
- The share of borrowers applying for adjustable-rate loans jumped to the highest in over two years.
- U.S. single-family housing starts <u>fell to an eight-month low</u> in March.
- 81% of potential home sellers believe they will get their asking price or more this year according to a new survey from Realtor.com.
- Here's why Americans still love McMansions.
- · Homebuilder confidence rose slightly in April.

#### **NEW YORK UPDATE**

- According to the NYC Comptroller, President Trump's trade war could cost the city nearly 36,000 jobs by the end of 2025.
- <u>Andrew Cuomo was endorsed</u> by the labor groups 32BJ SEIU and Hotel and Gaming Trades Council.
- New rules and high costs have limited outdoor dining options in NYC.
- The share of Manhattan home sales involving a trust <u>surged to 28% last year</u>, according to data from real estate analytics firm Attom.
- Congestion pricing deterred an average of roughly <u>82,000 vehicles from entering Manhattan below 60th Street</u> each day in March.
- The Trump administration has taken over the <u>\$7B</u> reconstruction project for NYC's Penn Station.
- The Empire State Manufacturing Index rose in April but remains in negative territory.
