- The President also announced a 50% tariff on copper imports beginning August 1, and 30% tariffs on the EU and Mexico.

NEW YORK UPDATE

- New York State is facing a \$750 million gap in the current fiscal year and at least \$3 billion next year due to federal Medicaid reductions.
- New York City's construction industry remains smaller than it was before the Covid-19 pandemic, according to an analysis by the state comptroller.
- Mayor Adams' administration must implement a package of laws passed by the City Council to expand eligibility for the city's rental subsidy program, an appeals court ruled.
- The NYC Council is close to approving a major rezoning of Midtown that could lead to the creation of 9,700 new homes.
